I have now received comment from the County Council Noise Engineer (Richard Peers). Richard has indicated that the information supplied includes a detailed noise assessment. This includes ambient noise monitoring and predictions for the gas generator. No further information is necessary although the predictions are based on a survey of an existing site and I would suggest that a visit to such a site would be advisable/necessary in order that the report's assumptions can be validated.

I have also taken the opportunity to look through the Phase 2 Briefing Note. The main issues that were raised by local residents during the determination of Phase 1 of the development (ref. SM.10/06/161 M) have been included in the Briefing Note.
